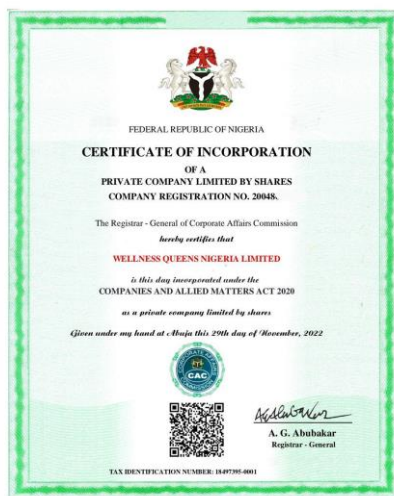

We ensure proper drying, dehydration and maximum cleanliness in processing as well as sterilized herb powders that will be fit for purpose. Here is a home where ethics is observed albeit behind the customer.

QUALITY ASSURANCE

To ensure the quality assurance of product for instance sesame seeds for export from Nigeria to the US, we consider so many things like the following steps:

1. Adherence to Regulatory Standards:
 - We confirm compliance with the quality and safety standards set by both Nigerian and US authorities. This includes regulations from bodies like the Nigerian Agricultural Quarantine Service (NAQS) and the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for the products that requires these regulatory standards, and also National Agency for Food and Drug Administration and Control (NAFDAC), etc., for the product that requires it.
2. Quality Control Measures:
 - We implement stringent quality control measures throughout the production process, including planting (ensuring it is organically grown) harvesting, and processed, and lastly, packaging suitable for long handling and one that befits the product.
3. Testing for Contaminants:
 - We conduct thorough testing for contaminants such as pesticides, aflatoxins, and heavy metals. We ensure there is no cross contamination during processing and ensure it is well dehydrated.
 - We ensure that the sesame seeds meet the maximum allowable limits set by international standards.
4. Certification:
 - We obtain necessary certifications, such as the Certificate of Analysis (COA), to validate the quality and safety of the sesame seeds. This documentation is crucial for customs clearance and we do it using certified laboratories.
5. Traceability:
 - Establish a traceability system to track the production and processing history or origin of the sesame seeds. This ensures transparency and facilitates quick identification of any issues.
6. Packaging Standards:
 - We use packaging materials that meet international standards to prevent contamination during transit. Clearly label packages with necessary information, including batch numbers and expiration dates.
7. Transportation Conditions:
 - We ensure that transportation conditions, including temperature and humidity, are suitable to maintain the quality of the sesame seeds during

transit. We use appropriate packaging to protect against external factors like rain or water.

8. Documentation:

- We prepare accurate and complete export documentation, including phytosanitary certificates and certificates of origin. Verify that all required paperwork is in order to facilitate smooth customs clearance in the importer's Country, and also get a Clean Certificate of Compliance from our Agent who is in charge of delivery processes.

9. Communication with Importers:

- We continue to maintain open communication with the importers. Address any concerns they may have and provide them with the necessary documentation and information to build trust in the quality of the sesame seeds.

10. Continuous Monitoring and Improvement:

- We implement a system for continuous monitoring and improvement. Regularly review and update quality assurance processes based on feedback, changes in regulations, or advancements in industry best practices.

For Powders like Fadogia Agrestis,

- We collect the stems from the farmers, who have traveled far into the forest to collect them.
- Wash off the sand, dirt and separate the leaves from stems.
- We then go ahead and drain.
- We dehydrate to drain stems.
- We crush the stems into tiny bits, then we give it a sun-drying/open air drying using clean materials and in clean conditions.
- When they are totally dried, we mill with our machines.
- After milling, we sun-dry for the second time to eliminate any moisture.
- We then transfer to the locals within the farmhouse to sieve wearing gloves and face masks.
- We fine-mill 3 more times to get a finer textured powder.
- We sterilize the fine-milled powder in a closed-oven system at a good temperature.
- We allow it to cool.
- Take some and package for Analysis.
- Then we pack in ziplock bags for shipping.

All these processes are done with care and hygiene.

NB: Again, if the stems are not thoroughly dried, they would not be able to be blended into smooth powder. And when it is dehydrated and sterilized, powder comes fluffy like flour.

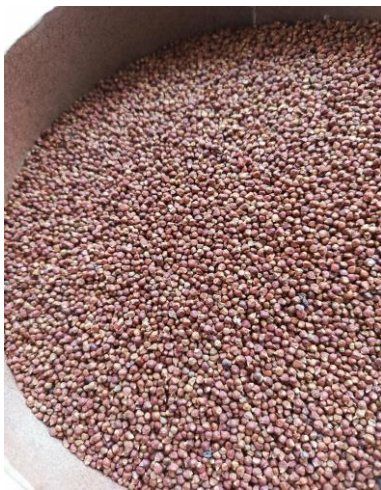
